All dinner money must be paid as the school cannot afford to subsidise it. Please send all money into school in a sealed envelope clearly marked.

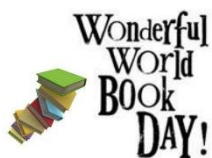
Sacraments
