



Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all still safe and well and surviving this very difficult time.

Again, I want to thank you for all your excellent effort in supporting the children with their online learning. The uptake with our online Distance Learning platform See-Saw is very good and we are very grateful to everyone engaging.

Distance Learning will be available on See Saw from Tuesday 16th June. (Children are off 15th June as this is a Staff Development Day). Activities will be less formal and we request that you use emergency packs sent out pre lock down for last week 22nd-26th June.

All staff will be involved in getting the school shut down for 2019-2020 and preparing for 2020-2021 school year during the last two weeks as best we can. There is a lot to do!

The staff are really missing the children as well and we all wish that our school could be back running as normal.

Unfortunately, as I'm sure you can tell from the media, there is a severe lack of guidance/communication/clarity on exactly when we are returning for 2020/2021 and how exactly this will look. Currently the proposed date for receiving guidance is June 26th!

As I said in letter on May 22nd when I know what way things are going to be in 2020-2021, I will inform you as soon as possible and I apologise in advance for the upset of this late notification (when it finally takes place!)

We hope as many children as possible can attend our Sport's Days on Wed/Thursday/Friday next week in conjunction with Healthy Kidz.

To make things as safe as possible we ask that children can be collected 10mins before the end of each session to allow us time to sanitise and clean equipment and toilets in between each session.

10.30am session-please collect at 11.20am

11.30am session-please collect at 12.20am

1.30pm session-please collect at 2.20pm

2.30pm session-please collect at 3.20pm

The children's class books will be left out on tables per class to be collected in a plastic bag with their name on it. Please collect when you are dropping your child off.
